NØRRELANDSKIRKENS KOR



Nørrelandskirkens kor is a church choir. When Gitte Støvring Preussler took over the choir in 2001, the choir was a treble choir of SSA. But small boys will grow up, and the choir is now a youth choir including boys and young men. The choir consists of three divisions: A treble choir SSA, a youth choir SAB (10-15 y) and an elementary choir (9-12 y). All singers in the elementary choir get supplementary aural training, and when they pass level 2 in the progressive educational program of Folkekirkens Ungdomskor, they sing in the SSA as well as the SAB choir. Norrelandskirken Kor performs at all services in Norreland Church en enrich the services with a lot of music. The choir often take part in evensongs and concerts in Holstebro and other cities.

Gitte Støvring Preussler



Educated as Organist and choir conductor in 1991 at the Carl Nielsen Academy of Music, Odense. Three years additional studies in childrens choir conducting at the Academy of Music, Aalborg. One year additional studies in Music communication at VMK - Academy of Music and Music Communication, Esbjerg, and one year additional studies in Music Pedagogy at VMK - Academy of Music and Music Communication, Esbjerg. Employed as organist and choir director at Nørrelandskirken, Holstebro.

1999- 2008 Vice-president/President of "Folkekirkens Ungdomskor". Co-founder of the Danish National Youth Choir for talented singers. Took an active part in designing the educational program for the singers of Folkekirkens Ungdomskor.

Clara Schumann Children and Youth Choir Berlin



The Clara Schumann Children and Youth Choir celebrates this year its 30th anniversary. The choir was founded in 1981 by Karola Marckardt at the Music school in Berlin-Lichtenberg. The choir counts 45 members, boys and girls who are between 10 and 23 years old. The choir's repertoire consists of pieces from many different epochs, but the contemporary children's choir literature plays a very significant role. The choir has taken part in radio and TV programmes and recorded several CDs. Numerous concerts in the Concert Hall "Schauspielhaus" at the Gendarmenmarkt, in the Philharmonie and in many other concert halls in Berlin as well as the successful participation in competitions and festivals in Germany and abroad (San Francisco/USA, Slovenia, Croatia, Australia, Great Britain, Italy, Estonia, Poland and Slovakia) show the potential of this choir. The most recent success of the choir is the first place at the European music festival for the youth in Neerpelt, Belgium, in 2010. The Clara Schumann Children and Youth Choir is a member of the Choir union in Berlin.

Ute Franzke



studied Music and History at Humboldt University in Berlin and now works as a school teacher. She gained the competence for conducting from Prof. Peter Vagts (Berlin), Prof. Hans-Peter Schurz (Berlin), Prof. Dan- Olof Stenlund (Malmö) and Prof. Kurz Hofbauer (Vienna).

From 1992 to 2002 she conducted the Children and Youth Choir "Kurt Schwaen", Berlin, which was founded by her. Since 2001 she is responsible for the music department of the Rudolf Virchow Secondary School in Berlin. Furthermore Ute Franzke conducts a plucked string orchestra in Berlin since 2007. In September 2008 she took over the The Clara Schumann Children and Youth Choir, Berlin.
