YOUNG VOICES

Children and Youth choir "Young Voices" from Lansingerland near Rotterdam consists of four groups: A Preschool class, a Choir class, a Children's Choir and a Youth Choir, ranging in level and age, with approximately 40 members. The choirs are under the expert guidance of conductor Rosemarijn Kalis.



The choir gives two concerts each year, an Advent-/Christmas Concert, and a Summer Concert to close the season. Except for the preschool class all groups participate in these concerts. The choirs also receive regular invitations to give concerts and to cooperate at special concerts, such as the annual "Matthäus Passion" of J.S. Bach, and Church services. As a result of the serious and continuous development of the quality of the choir, it is frequently being asked to participate large projects, for example: "Noah's Fluide" and "The Nicolas Cantate" both by Benjamin Britten. The repertoire covers from contemporary songs to mostly classical and polyphonic compositions, both a capella and accompanied.

CHOIR DIRECTOR ROZEMARIJN KALIS

Rozemarijn Kalis is conductor and artistic director of Children's and Youth Choir 'Young Voices' in Lansingerland since 2010.



She received her degree in Classical singing at the Rotterdam Conservatory Co-darts in 2007. She continued her education with a study in choral conducting with Wiecher Mandemaker, and received her Master degree in 2011. Rozemarijn has specialized in working with children and young adults. For years, she was a member of the Dutch National Youth Choir led by Wilma ten Wolde. Rozemarijn is associated with the Dutch National Children's and Youth Choir as a teacher, and in 2009 also as interim conductor. She is the conductor of the Leiden Chamber Choir in her home town. As a singer, she is a member of the professional Laurens Collegium Rotterdam.

Christophorus-Jugendkammerchor Versmold



Hans-Ulrich Henning founded the choir in 1979 together with pupils of the Christophorus School in Versmold. The choir, with six hours of rehearsals, professional vocal training and frequent week-long choir camps, enjoys exceptionally good opportunities for development. Thus, it is not surprising that the choir has won numerous first prizes in national and international competitions, amongst them the Grand Prix in Olomous / Czech Republic in 1993.

In 2002, within the framework of the AMJ (Working Group for Music and the Young) project "Composers compose for children's and youth choirs", it gave the world premiere of a piece by the Munich composer Max Beckschäfer. In 2004 the choir gave a guest performance in Kaunas in Lithuania as the only amateur ensemble at the "IX Pazaislio Muzikos Festivalis".

The programs of the Christophorus Youth Chamber Choir include sacral and secular choir pieces from the Renaissance to the modern music as well as sophisticated arrangements of the light music. The vocal diversity confirms the choir motto: "Singing is breathing, breathing is living!"

Choir director Hans-Ulrich Henning



Choir director Hans-Ulrich Henning made his first choir experience between 1961 and 1969 in the boy's choir of the Stiftkantorei Gütersloh, studied from 1969 to 1974 school music at the University of Music and Drama in Hannover. Between 1975 and 1980, vocal studies at the College for Music Detmold, completed with the federal singing teacher examination. Further experiences: Soloist work as tenor in church music context as well as in the renowned vocal quartet DROPS. Choir directing assistantship and voice teacher for several oratorios choirs, director of the Collegium Cantorum Gütersloh and of the CJD Orchestra, leader of workshops for choir directors, jury member for 'Jugend musiziert' and for the 'Berliner Festspiele'.
